Yew Axis Activity Stage

Thuringia will be providing a programme for young and old on the Yew Axis Activity Stage. The programme will begin with the children's channel KiKa, based in Thuringia, which will bring the popular TanzAlarm Show to the stage and invite the audience to join in. That will be followed by fun punk-rock from the band Psycho Ska Funk'L – six musicians who create a happy and cheerful atmosphere.

Presidential Garden Stage

Art and culture that bring people together:
Between 11.00 and 19.00, the German-Czech Future will
present its diverse entertainment and interactive programme
on the Presidential Garden Stage: there will be concerts
ranging from folk pop to gypsy and jazz, workshops on
acrobatics, juggling, theatre and dance and, finally, a
professional puppet show from Prague as well as
German-Czech cabaret.

Children's programme

A bike track, face-painting, crafts and quizzes – the programme provided for our young guests by around 60 partners is colourful. Learning, having fun, marvelling – the stage programme also offers a lot of variety from children's readings to a puppet show.

Galatea and Central Axis Activity Stages

Two stages, a wide variety of entertainment: Young and old literature fans can look forward to readings by authors – including Renate Bergmann and Jaroslav Rudiš – on the Galatea Axis Activity Stage.

Acrobatics, hula hoop acts and music from the Cool Kids from Neukölln can be seen on the Central Axis Activity Stage. And between the acts, there will be interesting interviews and discussions with our partners.
